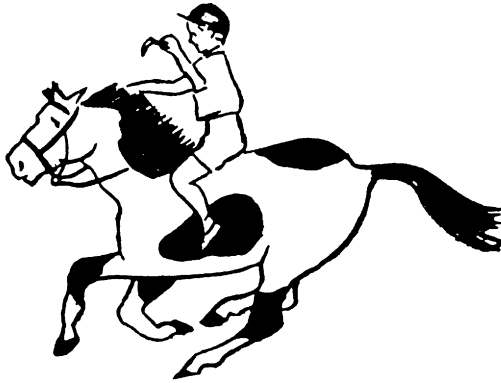

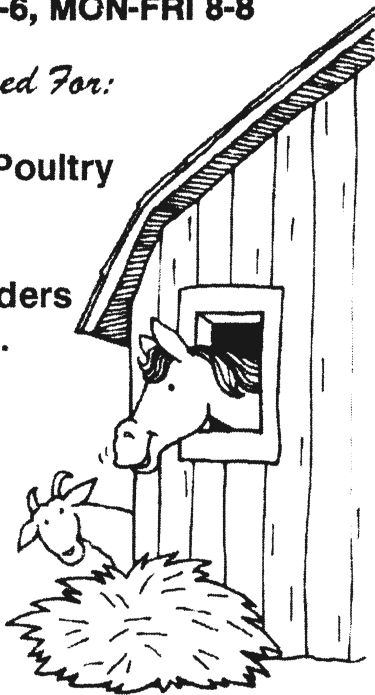

- B. Approved safety helmet must be worn at all times while mounted.

- D. The Show Committee reserves the right to change the order of classes and make cancellations if so warranted.
- E. Pre-entries CLOSE THURSDAY, AUGUST 25, 2011. Pre-entries will be accepted by traditional mail with the attached form or by e-mail to wlc17@aol.com or www.pickeringhunt.org. No call in entries will be accepted.
- F. Entry fees will be \$15.00 per class except for the Stake Classes, which are \$20.00 per class.
- G. A fee of \$10.00 will be charged for each junior rider who wishes to be eligible for the Best Child Rider Award.
- H. POST ENTRIES will be charged \$5.00 extra per class.
- I. The decision of the judges shall be final.
- J. Dogs will not be permitted on the show grounds unless restrained on a lead.
- K. The Pickering Pony Show will not be responsible for loss or damage to any person, property, or equipment, which may occur before, during or after the show.
- L. Six ribbons will be awarded in each class.
- M. A NEGATIVE COGGINS TEST taken within the 12 month period prior to the show date must accompany each entry.

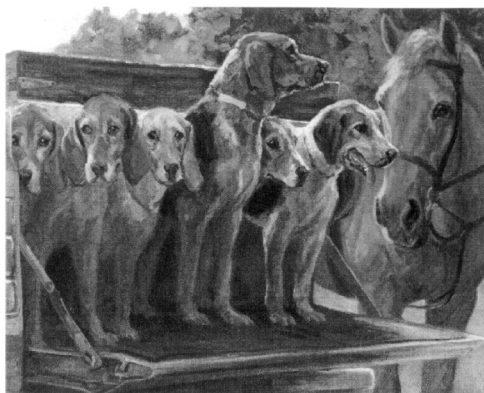
